Discussion Points

2. **Federal Updates**
 - a. HHS announced there will be no penalties if consumers are enrolled by March 31, 2014, regardless of when coverage begins.
3. **State Updates:**
 - a. Four contracts were awarded for IPA's.
 1. Primary Care Association
 2. Valley Health
 3. Community Care
 4. Partners in Health
 - b. The OIC has a Memorandum of Understanding with SHIP and CHIP. There are approximately 200 Assisters with the contracts and agreements. The OIC has requested from CMS the numbers of CAC's and agents and we will pass the information along to all stakeholders when it is received.

Q: What percentage of time are groups dedicating to enrollment?
A: Maximus IPA's are getting out in the communities they serve letting consumers know where to receive help.

Q: What examples of community locations are they visiting?
A: Focusing on libraries, courthouses, local business, grocery stores and community bulletin boards. Maximus is attending events that have been approved by the OIC. The presentation is approved by the OIC and will be sent out to all Stakeholders.

Q: Is there a schedule of events?
A: Not at this time. As it is developed it will be shared. On another note we must have secure locations to enroll consumers. Networks must be secure and this limits the number of locations.

 - d. WV AHC mentioned that school nurses are a potential resource they are trying to work with.
