## Discussion Points

1. **What's New OIC newsletter** – The newsletter is a great resource for all types of information and activities regarding exchanges. 2. **Federal Updates**
  - a. Final Integrity Rule Posted on Regtap.
  - b. Final Minimum Essential Coverage Rule posted on Regtap.
  - c. Two navigator organizations were chosen for WV; however, one returned the grant money. CMS is deciding whether to go down the list or re-bid. Advanced Patient Advocacy will be in seven hospitals.
  - d. CAC applications have not all been reviewed. The WVHA reported that one of their hospitals had been approved as a CAC. The Partnership of African American Churches has also been approved.
  
3. **State Updates:**
  - a. Coventry withdrew from the Marketplace.
  - b. Maximus contract has been signed and they are working to bring the management team on board. Next step is to award the entity grants which may happen by the 13<sup>th</sup>.
  - c. Encouraged everyone to complete Navigator Training. Only those from Navigator organizations will actually get certification certificate, but anyone may complete the training.
    - Q:** When will the plans and rates be released?
    - A:** We are still waiting on CMS approval and will release rates October 1.
  
4. **Other Updates:**
  - a. Dr. Paula Fitzgerald and Louise Moore presented the preliminary results from the ACA Questionnaire.
  - b. The initial phase studied individual coverage. The second phase will move to SHOP data.
    - Q:** Can we break down the “Probably Qualify for Tax Credits” into insured vs. uninsured?
    - A:** Yes, they believe the data collected will support this.
    - Q:** Can this information be used as a training tool for IPAs?
    - A:** Yes, with the OIC’s permission. Permission was granted.
    - Q:** In regards to income, was there a separation requested in earned vs. unearned?
    - A:** No, simply asked household income.
    - Q:** At any point, was the word “Obama-care” used?
    - A:** No.

**Q:** Can you break out by gender/age?

**A:** Yes. For now we can tell you the youngest was in his early 20's and the oldest was 73.

**Q:** Who paid for the study?

**A:** The study was funded from the Federal Grant.
