


WHAT WVCHIP PARENTS SAY ABOUT HEALTH INSURANCE


CHIP (Children’s Health Insurance Program) members’ parents are among those most likely to be customers of the Health Care Marketplace in 2014. WVCHIP, in consultation with The Offices of the Insurance Commissioner (OIC), developed a survey to ask the parents questions related to their insurance status, insurance affordability, health status, and other questions important in determining how these households will choose health care insurance coverage through the “Marketplace.” The questions were designed to assist both agencies in planning for the upcoming insurance changes in 2014. WVCHIP designed a web-based survey and a postcard was sent to 23,122 CHIP households the week of March 11, 2013. Responses were collected from 1,250 households up through April 5, 2013. The response rate was 5.4%, which ensures the survey is a valid tool with results that can be applied to the general population of CHIP households.



Does your spouse or significant other adult in your household have health care insurance that covers you?




There are several reasons someone may be without health insurance, which one applies to you?



How many children under the age of 19 years live permanently in your residence?




Did you file Federal taxes in the previous year?





Are you working for pay?




Do you currently have health care coverage?



How much do you pay for your insurance premium each month?




What is your annual deductible?



Does your health care plan have an out-of-pocket limit?




What is the annual out-of-pocket limit you are responsible for?



In the past 12 months, how many times did you receive care in a hospital emergency room?




Are you currently seeing a PCP for ongoing treatment or management of a medical condition?
